Footnotes

NICOLA'S NICKERS stalked the pace, closed and bid late turn, dueled through the stretch and just prevailed under a drive. GOLDEN GIRL SUE set a pressured pace, was joined in earnest late turn, dueled to the wire but was outfinished. ROMAN DAMSEL raced off the pace, closed between foes leaving the turn then rallied late outside. GROUP HUG, rated off the pace, closed four-wide on the far turn and chased through the stretch. MICHELLE'S TRIP forced the pace to the top of the stretch then evened out. ASKEATON stalked up close, chased on the far turn then evened out in the final 16th. OCALA DAWN, in touch between rivals, chased on the far turn but failed to menace.
