Footnotes

CALL TO FAITH had brief speed then pressed the pace, took command early turn, shook clear at the top of the stretch and held under a hand ride. ATTICUS APPLE set a pressured pace, bore out a little at the turn and lost the lead a few jumps later, chased up close to the stretch and finished all out. MIGHTY BEAR stalked the pace, chased late turn and finished determinedly. VOWS IN HOUSTON settled off the pace, was in range on the turn then flattened out in the final furlong. MR MCGREGOR, in range, chased hard late turn then evened out in the late stages. SILVER STRIKER stalked the pace, chased two-wide on the turn then tired in the stretch. PRIMED AND READY raced in midpack, chased five-wide late turn then flattened out in the final furlong.
