WISDOM FURY raced off the pace, closed four-wide on the far turn, rallied and got up late, driving. ATLANTIC SURGE raced midpack, was hustled three-wide on the far turn, cut to the rail upper stretch, rallied gamely and missed. KUMA raced prominently, was three-wide on the first turn then dueled two-wide on the backstretch and turn, wore down HIGH ACT on the far turn, vied with BILBO and shook clear upper stretch then weakened grudgingly in the late stages. EL COMMENCHERO raced off the pace along the rail, rallied late inside. DAKOTA FREEWAY had brief speed, settled on the first turn, stalked the pace, chased on the turn then hung in the stretch. BILBO stalked three-wide, bid early on the far turn, dueled to the stretch and tired in the final furlong. SPIRITWOOD trailed the field and never threatened. HIGH ACT was prominent early, dueled from the inside but tired on the far turn.
