STORMY RUSH never far back, bid on the turn while three wide, took on the leader in the drive, put that one in his pocket and then drew away as much the best. SOMETHING EXTRA bobbled at the break and off a step slow, was checked while in tight and between foes going into the turn, kept in the game, bid from just off the rail and was game for the place. DEVILISH STUNT had speed outside, vied early and led on the turn then failed to match the winner in the drive and was outfinished for the place. EXPLOSIVE'S BEST bumped hard at the break, was off the pace before coming widest into the stretch then rallied willingly but late. LONESOME CHEROKEE had an outside trip while in mid pack then lacked a strong stretch kick from the 7-path. WEEKEND WILDCAT veered in at the break bumping rival then was off the pace, never close and showed little. HANK'S HILL had inside speed to vie early, was in the hunt entering the turn then faltered and was all done in early stretch. MR. ECUVEE was off the pace, had no bid and never a factor.
