**Footnotes**

THE BEAR VOW broke inward and bumped a rival at the start, raced in midpack, chased three and four-wide on the turn, rallied gamely and got up late under a drive. AIR BLADE, sandwiched at the outset, settled off the pace, chased from the rail on the turn, bid a furlong out and moved clear but failed to hold the winner safe. CAPE RACE, herded at the start, bumped with a rival, settled off the pace, chased three and four-wide on the turn and finished gamely. CATCH THE SUN, off alertly, pressed the pace, forced the issue on the turn, dueled into the stretch but gave way with a furlong to run. MATTER OF HASTE drifted out at the start, set a pressured pace, was joined at the top of the stretch and gave way. POLITICAL ERA stalked the pace, was in range to the top of the stretch and tired.
