Footnotes

GUPPY SMUGGLER, always in range, stalked five-wide into the stretch, was asked for run, dueled with TWENTY BLACK and took command under a drive in the late stages. TWENTY BLACK raced in midpack, chased late turn, bid outside GUPPY SMUGGLER a furlong out, dueled, but was outfinished. PRECIOUS STONE was hustled to the early lead then taken in hand, set a reserved pace, was collared at the 1/4 pole, dueled briefly and yielded grudgingly upper stretch. EXECUTIVE MANCER raced in midpack, chased into the stretch then evened out in the late stages. GOLDEN GILDA broke in the air, settled off the pace, chased on the turn then evened out in the stretch. THE QUEEN'S REIGN stalked the pace, bid at the 1/4 pole, was headed at the top of the stretch, chased, but flattened out late. BESO BONITA, in touch, bid along the rail late turn, shook clear at the top of the stretch but failed to stay in the final furlong. PRAYINGALLTHEWAY, well back early, was hustled on the turn but never reached contention.
