EMERALD EARRINGS moved up to take a short lead on the backstretch and was taken in hand, set a reserved pace, was engaged at the top of the stretch but moved clear quickly then held sway under a drive. THETACTICS OFDANCE pressed the pacesetter on the backstretch, stalked on the turn, bid outside EMERALD EARRINGS at the top of the stretch but could not match strides then finished gamely to save the place. MY LORDSHIP stalked the pace and was close up early, remained in hand three-wide on the turn then lacked the necessary response when roused and hung in the final furlong. VELVET SNOW raced midpack along the third path, was roused early stretch but evened out in the late stages. SAUVAGE (FR) was unhurried on the inside, moved onto the second path early turn then raced evenly and lacked a closing response. CHARMING PROPOSAL was always well back, saved ground and never reached contention. SURPRISED HUMOR stalked the pace, was hustled along the rail late turn but tired in the stretch. SPICE RACK raced well off the pace on the third path and lacked a closing response.
