T. T.'S POINT, well back early, closed along the rail early on the far turn, angled four-wide chasing late turn, swept by in the final furlong and held under a drive. QUINZEE raced off the pace, was hustled angling from two to six-wide on the far turn, chased into the stretch and rallied gamely. HAT TRICK KID led briefly, was headed midway of the clubhouse turn, forced the pace then pulled to the lead at the 1/2, had command under pressure to the final furlong, was passed and gave way . SMART FLIGHT stalked in hand, closed into the far turn, forced the pace three-wide, launched an all out bid upper stretch but failed to sustain the move and gave way. COOK'S LOOK stalked the pace, chased four-wide on the far turn, came five-wide at the top of the stretch then finished determinedly to no avail. SPRING RIDGE broke in the air, was kept off the early pace, angled from the third path to five-wide on the far turn, chased into the stretch but never reached contention. NORTHERN STORE, in range early, angled three to five-wide on the far turn, was hustled into the stretch then flattened out. PEACE BAY, in range outside rivals, raced five -wide to seven-wide on the far turn then lacked a rally. THE WORLD TO ME, in range between horses, chased into the stretch but tired in the final furlong. PARISIAN CHAT forced the pace, took command midway of the first turn, was headed at the 1/2, chased to midturn and tired.
