COURTVILLE, sent to the fore from the outset, dueled, was headed at the top of the stretch, bid quickly and coming in upper stretch and drove clear. MENLO CASTLE dueled, was headed at the top of the stretch, lost his path upper stretch and was steadied, recovered quickly and rallied gamely. COLLEEN'S SAILOR stalked early, chased three-wide late turn then rallied determinedly outside. DANGER BAY showed brief speed, dropped back nearing the turn, chased along the rail and took the lead at the top of the stretch but was caught almost immediately and yielded. WAR FLEET, squeezed back midway of the backstretch, was hustled from off the pace on the turn then evened out in the late stages. WHO DAT AMBUSH closed late backstretch, chased three to six-wide on the turn, was all out upper stretch then evened out. TOCET MAN broke outward, tendered a brief bid late backstretch, chased three to five-wide on the turn then flattened out in the stretch. SERGEANT SKI, in range on the backstretch, dropped back on the turn and lacked a response in the stretch. A CLAIM OF FOUL BY THE RIDER ON MENLO CASTLE AGAINST COURTVILLE FOR INTERFERENCE UPPER STRETCH RESULTED IN COURTVILLE BEING DISQUALIFIED AND PLACES SECOND.
