KING CITY forced the pace on the backstretch, bid outside the leader entering the turn, was quickly taken back and continued to press, rebid late turn but was well headed at the top of the stretch, responded smartly, lodged a third bid a furlong out and took command under a drive. ONE MORE DEAL led early, was pressed by the winner throughout then final yielded albeit grudgingly in the final furlong. THATBOATHASSAILED raced in midpack, closed into the turn, chased to the stretch and finished gamely in vain. ACEUPPHILLSLEEVE, in touch, chased three and four-wide on the turn but evened out in deep stretch. LOVE TO BATTLE raced off the pace, was hustled two and three-wide on the turn but never reached contention. PORTOMASO settled midpack, chased four and five-wide on the turn, was all out in the stretch but evened out in the late stages. BUBBLE GUM SHRIMP, off slowly, was hustled three and four-wide from from midpack on the turn then lacked a rally. CASH FOR LIFE settled off the pace, was blocked briefly late turn but failed to menace. PROFIT PREFERRED raced in midpack, was in striking range on the turn, saved ground then lacked a rally. ASAFABOLT raced midpack, was hustled four and five-wide on the turn then evened out in the stretch. ROSEVILLE, always well back, lacked a rally. DON'T SEND A BOY bolted inward just out of the gate, hit the rail and unseated his rider.
