Footnotes

FROSTY KISS stalked the early pace from the four path, loomed boldly at the 1/4 pole and wore down MYSTERIOUS AFFAIR in the drive. The latter dueled for the early lead, opened a clear lead in mid stretch but could not hold off the winner. EL PRADO ESSENCE was rushed to the lead along the rail and dueled for the early lead then weakened in late stretch. CRYPTIC RESPONSE was hustled along just off the rail, saved ground through the turn but lacked a late response. NATIONOFLITIGATION was close up in the backstretch outside of rivals then weakened. MEMA'S TURNING RED broke sharply then dropped back quickly, raced in the four path around the turn but lacked a late response. CASSIA was unhurried early between horses and never rallied. DECORATEDWITHONOUR was slow early off the rail and outrun. PORT MARIA was 3 wide and void of speed. COLEBROOKADVANTAGE was hustled along on the rail and never rallied.
