DESIRADE was in hand between horses, loomed boldly in the four path at the 1/4 pole and wore down I BEAT THE TORNADO in the drive under constant handling. The latter was away alertly and set the pace off the rail, held the lead to deep stretch before giving way in the final sixteenth. DANDY ANDY was allowed to settle 3 wide but lacked a late response and ran evenly. I BELIEVE I'MQUICK was void of early speed off the rail, made a mild bid in the turn but was never a threat. DAME AGNES was void of early speed on the rail but lacked a late response. LA MARQUETTE stumbled at the start then closed the gap well off the rail and was never a factor. ALPINE ASTER was hustled along pressing the early pace then faded in the turn.
