JET SET EXEC raced off the pace, angled from three to five-wide on the turn, was hustled into the stretch, angled out more, rallied determinedly and drove to the lead in the late stages. KING EDDIE raced midpack, closed late turn, bid a furlong out, drove clear but failed to hold the winner safe. ACED THE MOVES, well back early, angled from two to four-wide on the turn, angled out in the stretch and rallied fast, but late. HARRIER raced midpack two-wide, angled out upper stretch then finished gamely to no avail. CLARKSTONCHARM was used a bit in the early stages to reach the fore, forced the pace, bid early turn, dueled, drove clear upper stretch, ducked out a little from left-handed encouragement then tired. SEPTEMBER SQUARE stalked from the rail then two-wide, chased through the stretch but evened out late. WATHS UP PATRICK raced off the pace, was hustled from upper stretch and rallied late between foes. ABSOLUTION showed early speed, set a pressured pace, vied on the turn, yielded upper stretch and tired. RIMOUSKI stalked the pace, closed late turn, bid at the top of the stretch, was steadied when the leader came out, chased, then flattened out late. DERBY FOX, in range between rivals, stalked along the rail on the turn, chased in the stretch and tired. PRATTLE raced midpack early, dropped back on the turn, cut to the rail late turn then lacked a response in the stretch.
