BRILLIANT MOON raced off the pace, closed late turn, rallied five-wide and swept by the pacesetter in deep stretch to win under a drive. OPEN ZIPPER dueled briefly on the backstretch, took command, set a reserved pace then failed to contain the winner in the final 70 yards. SEALED BID settled well back, angled from the third path to six-wide on the turn then finished under an all out drive. LOLA B. raced midpack, angled from three-wide to four-wide late turn then finished gamely in vain. ATALANTA VELOX raced midpack, was hustled four and five-wide on the turn, chased into the stretch, was all out but evened out late. CUVECIOUS, well back early, angled two-wide to five-wide on the turn, lugged in while trying to close upper stretch and evened out. THIRD TIME LUCKY had brief speed then stalked the pace, chased late turn but evened out midstretch. SEJANO led briefly then stalked in hand, chased four-wide into the stretch and flattened out. PRIMA DANNA raced off the pace, saved ground then tired in the stretch.
