### Footnotes

CONTROLLED BLAST showed brief speed, chased on the turn, responded at the top of the stretch, swept to the lead in the final furlong and widened under a hand ride. PETER THE GROSS, in range, launched a quick move to take the lead midway of the backstretch, set a pressured pace then failed to hold the winner safe in the final furlong. DARE TO BE BEST settled off the pace, was hustled angling from the rail to five-wide on the turn, chased into the stretch and finished determinedly. PENSYLVANIAKING showed brief speed, dropped back midbackstretch, was hustled from three to six-wide on the turn then evened out in the stretch. DIAMONSDIPLOMAT, well back early, closed two and three-wide on the turn, finished gamely late inside but did not threaten. MOON CAT forced the pace early, chased angling from the rail to four-wide on the turn then tired in the stretch. RINK RAT, rated off the pace, came three-wide through the turn then lacked a rally. FOGO, rated off the pace, closed midbackstretch, chased on the turn, came five-wide to the top of the stretch but did not menace. GUNGA DAN closed on the backstretch, pressed the pace on the turn then tired at the top of the stretch. TAIL WIND TERRY, always well off the pace, lacked a closing response.
