WOODBOURNE, in range three-wide, closed into the stretch, bid midstretch and drove clear. CATCH THE LUCK raced off the pace along the rail, was hustled between foes late turn, launched an all out stretch drive and was gaining then hung late. BRAM'S CAT showed early speed and dueled, was headed and chased on the turn, bid upper stretch and led briefly, was no match for the winner midstretch and weakened. FOOLISH VOW raced midpack along the rail, came two-wide late turn, cut back to the rail upper stretch, moved close up to the leaders but flattened out. BLU THEM AWAY raced off the pace, was hustled three-wide late turn, rallied outside but needed more. SOURPOWER raced midpack, closed four-wide late turn, rallied and also needed more response. D. FLUTIE dueled, shook clear entering the turn, was headed upper stretch and tired. MANDERLAY settled, saved ground but lacked a strong closing response. ROYAL CREST raced off the pace, was hustled between foes late turn then evened out in the stretch. HOLY DREAMER raced midpack, saved ground, closed into the stretch then tired.
