Footnotes

LORD OF GREATNESS raced in midpack, chased four-wide late turn, rallied gamely and was just up, driving. CITIUS stalked the pace, bid four-wide midturn, dueled to the end just besting his rival but was caught by the winner at the wire. DEVIL IN WILLIE led early, was headed early on the main track and forced the issue, bid three-wide midturn, dueled but missed. DESTINY'S SONG stalked the pace, bid between horses late turn, dueled but gave way in the final 16th. JOMELO, away slowly, settled off the pace, chased four and five-wide on the turn and finished all out from the outside. BEAR'S FUTURE forced the issue, took a short lead on the main track, set a pressured pace, was joined midturn, dueled, but yielded grudgingly in the final furlong. TAPIT'S BREW, away slowly, was squeezed back a bit at the turn, chased into the stretch then evened out in the late stages.
