THE QUEEN'S STAMP raced off the pace along the rail, gave a strong late effort and got up in deep stretch, driving. MARIA CLARISSA raced midpack along the rail, angled out and rallied outside through the stretch and just missed. SUDSY BABY raced off the pace two-wide, angled out at the 1/8 pole and finished gamely. QUELLE BEAUTE settled after a good start, was hustled two-wide late turn and finished all out. UNREAL ROCKET, prominent along the rail, edged clear leaving the turn, led to deep stretch and tired. KAYLEE'S MAGIC stalked two-wide, moved three-wide late turn but flattened out late. MISS DOROTHY, prominent two-wide, was headed at the top of the stretch, chased the leader but tired late. OVEROCKS, in touch along the rail, was in range to the final furlong and tired.
