BEAR'S TENOR forced the pace from the rail, backed away a bit late turn and angled out, chased into stretch, bid quickly then drew clear and finished under a hand ride. MODIMO settled off the pace, chased on the far turn, rallied gamely and was up for the place. THORNWOOD ROAD, prominent early, moved clear into the backstretch, set the pace, was headed upper stretch and chased to the end. HIGH JUMPER stalked the pace, was hustled between foes on the far turn but evened out in the late stages. JUST PAUL raced off the pace, was hustled four and five-wide on the far turn but never reached contention. BEIHAI PARK settled off the pace, was hustled four and five-wide on the far turn but failed to menace. TRY RUNNING stalked the pace, was hustled four-wide into the stretch and tired.
