STORMY VOYAGE dueled, edged clear on the turn then widened under a drive in the stretch and was taken in hand nearing the wire. DREAMING IS FREE raced in midpack, chased two to four-wide on the turn then finished gamely. I'M TOO FAST settled off the pace, chased on the turn, came five-wide into the stretch and finished all out. SCREAMED PINACH dueled on the backstretch, was headed early turn and chased gamely to the end. RADIANT MISS stalked the pace, was hustled three-wide late turn then lacked a closing response. BRIGHT AWAY's tack slipped early but she stalked the pace, chased from the rail on the turn then flattened out in the stretch. SILVER SALOON settled off the pace, was hustled on the turn but never reached contention. CITY SUNSET, in touch early, dropped back late backstretch but lacked a rally.
