SHOREMAN vied for the early lead between horses, dropped back in the turn and moved to the rail, then rallied inside of rivals and prevailed under strong urging. PERSONAL SECRET vied for the early lead three wide, battled gamely to deep stretch, but weakened in the final strides. SUN TZU settled in the second flight inside of rivals, found his best stride in the drive and finished well three wide. SPICY PROSPECTOR was void of early speed between horses, angled out in upper stretch, but never rallied and was never a threat. PROMISING WEST was hustled along vying for the early lead, then tired in the stretch. SENOR STERLING was void of early speed three wide and outrun.
