Footnotes

THROUGH THICKNTHIN showed early foot then settled and stalked the pacesetter, bid early on the far turn, drove clear at the top of the stretch then held under steady handling. SAUCY SADIE stumbled at the start, remained unhurried to the far turn, closed steadily to the stretch, rallied gamely and was gaining on the winner. ASCOT LASS, in touch early, raced three-wide on the first turn then moved to the rail, was hustled through the far turn and evened out late. LUNAR SETTING raced off the pace, was four-wide on the first turn, moved to the rail and was hustled late on the far turn but never threatened. SWEET AFTON raced evenly, was four-wide on the first turn and between foes on the far turn then lacked rally. MORNING PRAYERS led on the first turn, set a reserved pace, was engaged early on the far turn, vied briefly then tired in the stretch. TEJANO THE QUEEN stalked two or three wide, failed with a bid into the far turn and tired.
