PHINEAS unhurried in the early going then wide and trailing into the stretch, flew home and caught the front runner at the wire. C'MON MAN dueled in the early going while three wide, broke clear and took command on the turn, was clear in the drive, looked home free then was caught at the wire by outside foe. HIGHLY FAVOURED tracked the three leaders, kept in touch with the front runner on the turn then a mild bid had him finishing best of the rest. JULES CAESAR vied inside in the early going, chased on the turn then evened out. KWIK COSTA off the pace and then inside for the stretch try, needed a kick. MR. TURNABOUT angle wide into the stretch from off the pace then did not menace. GAMBERONI saved ground and showed little. REGIONAL EXPERTISE vied between foes, backed off on the turn then faded.
