JENNY COME LATELY settled off the pace, chased five-wide on the turn, launched a determined drive and just missed. CELESTIAL GROVE pressed the pace on the backstretch, forced the issue on the turn, chased into the stretch then evened out in the late stages. HOLY WINE pressed the pace to the turn, was hustled along then flattened out in the stretch. DIAMOND GUN, close early, settled off the pace, chased three and four-wide on the turn but never reached contention. WINETTIE pressed the pace, gave way at the turn and tired. GO PLAY pressed the pace to the turn, gave way and tired.
