LUCKY LOTTO broke in the air and raced from off the pace, closed four-wide on the turn, rallied gamely and got by in deep stretch, driving. EXECUTIVE FIVE, in range, angled out chasing into the stretch, launched a determined drive but was outkicked in the final 70 yards. ROYAL EGBERT forced the pace, bid into the turn, dueled, shook clear briefly a furlong out then failed to hold late. TOP PROSPECT stalked the pace, chased four-wide into the stretch then evened out in the late stages. MALIBU SKYLINE had speed, was joined at the turn, dueled, yielded upper stretch and tired. GRAND OLD GAME, in range, saved ground, chased into the stretch then evened out in the final furlong. OCTAVO raced in midpack, dropped back on the turn, chased three-wide but showed no response in the stretch.
