**Footnotes**

FILL YOUR BOOTS stalked the pace, chased late turn then swept to the lead in the final furlong, driving. RHYTHM OF ROCK, in range, chased four-wide late turn and finished determinedly. NORTHERN BRUCE settled in midpack between foes, chased late turn and finished gamely. MOLINARO FT KNIGHT

set a pressured pace, was joined at the turn, dueled, was headed at the top of the stretch and chased to the end. MERCY STREET forced the issue, dueled on the turn, took command at the top of the stretch, was passed a furlong out and chased to the wire. MIDNIGHT BLACK, in range, chased two-wide late turn but evened out in the final furlong. ARTIC TUNDRA settled off the pace, was hustled hard late turn but never reached contention. HERE'S GEORGE, in touch between horses, chased late turn then flattened out in the final furlong. FIVE IN FRONT, in range, was hustled on the turn then evened out in deep stretch. A BIT OF DAN broke outward and bumped a rival, raced off the pace, was hustled on the turn then evened out in the stretch. MOMA RING raced off the pace, closed between foes late turn then evened out in the final furlong. KNIGHTS DESTINY, in midpack early, was hustled along the rail on the turn then tired in the stretch. BOOMER'S BEST BUD, squeezed back early, raced off the pace, was hustled along the rail on the turn but was never a factor. UP TO THE PLATE, bumped at the start, trailed throughout.
