Footnotes

BRIGHT REAGENT broke alertly, settled midpack, closed four-wide late turn then swept to the lead midstretch. HOOF BEATS stalked from the second path, moved out between horses late turn and was all out in the stretch. PRIZE AND HONOR vied between horses, shook clear at the top of the stretch then gave way in the final sixteenth. IF YOU'RE LUCKY, in touch on the rail, was game in the stretch but hung. GOLD FOR CANADA was hustled along three-wide then lacked a closing response. ASCOT IN THE GATE, well back on the second path, never reached contention. ALWAYS TOMORROW, unhurried early, raced three-wide on the turn and failed to threaten. REGAL GRAY dueled three-wide outside two others then gave way early turn and faded. CRAFTY CAUSE, well back early, lacked a rally inside. GLADIATORS CONSORT moved up to duel along the rail late backstretch but tired at the top of the stretch. SARAH'S PRIDE was through early, raced along the second path and trailed home.
