SIMPLY FRIENDS forced the pace early then stalked on the backstretch, chased four-wide late turn, took command a furlong out and held sway under a drive. NO IT ISN'T raced off the pace, was hustled four-wide late turn, chased through the stretch but evened out in the late stages. MATADORA raced in midpack, chased three-wide on the far turn then finished gamely between rivals. CHAMPAGNE DYNASTY pressed the pace, bid into the far turn and took a short lead, was engaged late turn, dueled but was headed upper stretch and flattened out. MARIANNA broke inward and was steadied, raced forwardly, was headed at the far turn, rebid inside the leader late turn, had a narrow lead at the top of the stretch but was passed a furlong out and gave way. U GET THE PICTURE stalked the pace early then settled in midpack, was roused four-wide late turn but did not threaten. WILDA raced off the pace, chased along the rail late turn then tired upper stretch.
