Footnotes

ONLY A ROSE stalked the pace, bid three-wide early turn and took a short lead, drove clear upper stretch then held under steady pressure. SIMPLY AGAIN closed behind foes late backstretch, gained three-wide on the turn and finished all out. HAUTE CUISINE held a short early lead, was always under pressure, was headed early turn, chased hard to the stretch then hung. JOYFUL JUNO broke in the air, raced midpack, was hustled along the rail through the turn but was never in contention. PURPURINA forced the pace from the rail on the backstretch, gave way early turn and faded steadily. CHINA RAIN, well back early, saved ground but never reached contention. MONEY NEVER SLEEPS, in touch five-wide, faded leaving the turn and lacked a late response. COFFEE TIME, also in touch early, faded four deep late turn. LIGHTHEARTED LAURA saved ground but was always outrun.
