KNIGHTS TEMPLAR stalked close up on the outside, bid four-wide leaving the turn, lost a bit of ground at the top of the stretch, rebid a furlong out and drove clear with a sixteenth to run. TRULY BLUSHED led quickly under strong restraint, quickened on the turn, was engaged late turn, shook clear briefly at the head of the stretch, was engaged a furlong out and gave way midstretch. TASHA'S DELIGHT raced off the pace, was roused midturn, moved off the rail leaving the turn and rallied late outside. TOP NOTCH LADY pressed the pace, moved up inside TRULY BLUSHED and forced the pace into the turn, gave way quickly unable to match strides, chased to the stretch and hung with an all out effort. SUDSY BABY pressed the pace, forced the issue up inside TOP NOTCH LADY entering the turn, gave way past midturn and lacked a late response. ONE RING settled quickly, was roused along the rail late turn but was never a factor. GLORIA'S LEGACY, always well back, moved from the second path to the fourth path through the turn but had no stretch response.
