

KITTY AVENUE settled off the pace, angled out closing late turn then rallied belatedly. CLASSY BREW raced off the pace, was hustled along three-wide then flattened out in the stretch. ALLWAYS EXQUISITE broke in the air, raced off the pace, was hustled late turn but never reached contention. MATHURA chased from off the pace along the rail and lacked a rally. VALID VISA broke in the air, was far back but was hustled along the rail.
