CURIOSITY trailed early, closed three-deep late on the turn, rallied gamely and just got up. JULIET'S KISS, well back early, closed four-wide late turn, got up late but just missed. WEST BEWARE gained steadily three-wide, was roused at the top of the stretch, gained command at the 1/8 pole then faltered. CIELO MOON dueled to the far turn, shook clear, led to the final furlong and tired. LIVE WELL, well back early, closed four-wide on the far turn then hung in the final furlong. LARRY'S SMILE stalked the pace from the second path and evened out in the stretch. GENIVER stalked the pace, pressed on the far turn then tired upper stretch. JUST FOR JEAN raced midpack, was hustled three-deep on the far turn then flattened out in the stretch. MACDASHI raced midpack and was through early. LET'S MOMBO dueled from the rail, tired entering the far turn and was eased in the stretch.
