STAG NATION closed three-deep, bumped with a rival upper stretch, bid a furlong out and outfinished PURPLE PASSAGE. PURPLE PASSAGE stalked close up three-wide, bid at the top of the stretch, got clear and was all out but failed to hold off the winner. DANCE WITH RAVENS broke alertly, settled and stalked the pace from between horses, was blocked in the stretch but angled to the inside and finished gamely once clear. NEWBURY saved ground, was blocked at the top of the stretch, angled out and finished well when clear. NUMEROUS LUCK, bumped at the start, raced well back and three-deep, bid midstretch but failed to match strides. EL SLORIDNO raced midpack while four-wide, bumped with a rival early stretch then hung. SOMEBODY SMART trailed from the rail, encountered severe traffic problems upper stretch and failed to menace. SNUFF closed four-wide late turn, bumped twice with the same rival and once with another then hung. EXOFFICIO stalked close up from the rail, was blocked at the top of the stretch then showed no late response. AUTUMN SNOW forced the issue, dueled on the turn and tired in the stretch. BAXTER CREEK held a short early lead, dueled from the rail on the turn then yielded at the top of the stretch and tired.
