BIOFUEL, rated in range, closed angling out from the third to the fifth path on the far turn, responded smartly and got up in deep stretch under a strong drive and a theatrical finish. ASKBUT I WON'TTELL, in range, closed on the backstretch and pressed the leader on the turn, chased into the stretch, bid a furlong out and drove clear but failed to contain the winner at the wire. MUCH OBLIGED settled off the pace, gained midpack by the half, stalked the pace on the far turn then finished gamely in vain. HOOH WHY, away sharply, set a strongly reserved pace, quickened late on the far turn, was engaged a furlong out and gave way grudgingly. TASTY TEMPTATION settled at the rear of the pack but still in range, was contentious on the far turn and roused near the 1/4 pole but flattened out in the final furlong. DANCE FOR US stalked the pace to the far turn, faded under a ride on the turn and was through.
