CAFE AU LAIT stalked the pace well in hand, bid four-wide midturn, was headed at the top of the stretch, rebid in the final furlong and drove clear. YOSHI MORI bid along the rail late backstretch, gained a narrow lead on the turn, shook clear at the top of the stretch, was quickly caught, gave chase and held the place. LYNNESSA, in touch, closed angling five-wide late turn then finished all out. MAUNA KEA, off slowly, moved up and stalked the pacesetter from the rail, angled out late turn but finished evenly. KRZ EXECUTIVE set a pressured pace, was joined at the turn, gave way late turn and tired. GYPSY'S KIN raced off the pace, was hustled on the turn, came five-wide into the stretch but never reached contention. NIIGON'S BEAUTY, in touch, chased on the turn, angled in a bit nearing the top of the stretch but was not a threat. FALCON FOREST forced the pace, gave way quickly early turn and faded steadily.
