### Footnotes

VALOREM, off alertly, led into the first turn and was well in hand, was joined early on the backstretch, dueled along the rail to the wire and prevailed late under a drive. VARIABLE RATE bid early on the backstretch, dueled to the wire but was outfinished. LADY GEEGEE stalked the duel, chased three and four-wide on the far turn and was all out through the stretch. JUST B POSITIVE stalked the pace, dropped back nearing the far turn, launched her drive and circled six-wide into the stretch and finished gamely. COLINS NIGHTINGALE settled off the pace, closed between rivals into the far turn, chased three and four-wide and finished best of the rest. ME AND A BREEZE raced off the pace, was hustled between foes on the far turn but flattened out in the final furlong. LIFTOFF LADY raced in midpack, saved ground, dropped back late turn and tired. ICE QUEEN raced in midpack, was hustled four and five-wide on the far turn then tired at the top of the stretch.
