Footnotes

SHINE FOR US was allowed to settle just off the rail, roused three wide on the turn and wore down NABETHIAN under strong steady pressure. The latter sped to the early lead in hand, opened a clear lead on the turn and widened the margin in the drive, but weakened in the late going and gave way. FRESH BELIEVER chased the early leader from the three path and ran evenly. SWINGING JANIE GAL was allowed to settle along the rail, saved ground on the turn and finished with a mild rally. AMY'S BELIEVER was allowed to settle between horses on the turn and never a threat. STORYBOUND was void of early speed off the rail, roused three wide on the turn, but was never a threat. AWESOME VIEW was unhurried early widest, then dropped back on the turn and faded quickly in the drive.
