CHIEF BEAR stalked the pace, closed four-wide late turn, bid at the top of the stretch and quickly drove clear then widened under a drive and was taken in hand at the wire. PALMERS, off slowly, raced midpack on the backstretch, closed on the far turn, came five-wide to the top of the stretch then finished determinedly. IT'S A DANZIG raced off the pace, was hustled three and four-wide on the far turn then finished gamely. STOLONBOY raced midpack in hand, was hustled on the far turn then evened out in the late stages. EOLOS, rated off the pace, angled from four-wide to six-wide on the far turn, chased through the stretch but never reached contention. STEP ON UP dueled early, was headed late on the first turn, stalked the pace, chased into the stretch and tired in the final furlong. APALACHEE STORM dueled, moved clear into the backstretch, set the pace, was engaged and quickly passed at the top of the stretch and tired.
