MARCHFIELD, unhurried to the far turn, closed angling from two to four-wide, rallied gamely, challenged a furlong out, dueled to the end and prevailed under a drive. CHAMPS ELYSEES (GB) raced off the pace, closed three-wide late turn, angled out a bit upper stretch, rallied, dueled inside MARCHFIELD from outside the final furlong but was outfinished. MEDJOOL raced midpack, closed into the far turn, chased three-wide then was all out through the stretch. MARLANG set a reserved pace, was pressured on the turn, dueled into the stretch and gained a short lead, held the advantage but was passed a furlong out. COOL GATOR, well back early, closed under a strong ride on the far turn, continued gamely in the stretch but never reached contention. RAHY'S ATTORNEY stalked the leader, closed up and was lapped on early on the far turn, bid in earnest late turn, was headed upper stretch, kept after the pacesetter but both were passed a furlong out. CATCH THE LUCK, in range, saved ground but tired in the stretch. WOODBOURNE was in range to midturn, showed no response and faded.
