Footnotes

RUBY SHOES stalked the early pace in the backstretch, closed the gap three wide on the turn, assumed command entering the stretch and drew clear under steady urging. MISS BENNY was void of early speed, saved ground on the turn and finished with a late rally along the rail. FAFNIR was unhurried early just off the rail, saved ground on the turn and finished with a mild rally. RUBY TANGO vied for the early lead going three wide, assumed command on the turn, but tired in the drive. OUT WELL pressed the early pace between horses, then dropped back in the turn. CLASSICAL ROMANCE was allowed to settle between horses and never rallied. CASHMERE was void of early speed off the rail and never rallied. RIDING THE WAVES was unhurried early four wide and never rallied. CAMPAIGN PROMISE showed brief speed racing four wide, then dropped back in the turn. TRULY STORMY vied for the early lead inside of rivals, then tired in the stretch. DEPUTY DIVA was void of early speed and outrun.
