STRAIT FROM TEXAS was shuffled back at the start and allowed to settle off the rail, made a quick move five wide on the turn, opened a clear lead in upper stretch and held off HOT TALENT under strong steady pressure. The latter was allowed to settle just off the rail in the early going, swung to the outside and followed the winner on the turn, continued well off the rail and outside of STRAIT FROM TEXAS in the drive closing the gap in the final strides. LUSH SOLDIER was allowed to settle off the rail in the early going, closed the gap on the turn, but was blocked briefly four wide entering the stretch, split horses in the drive and finished well. MY GABRIELLE vied for the early lead widest, opened a clear advantage at the three eighths pole, and weakened in the drive. SMART CHOICE vied for the early lead between horses, then tired in the stretch and dropped back. BAILEYS EAGLE was void of early speed off the rail and lacked a late response. ATLANTIC FURY was hustled along pressing the early pace inside of rivals, then dropped back on the turn. MISS GRINDSTONE set a pressured pace between horses, then got tired on the turn and dropped back. EXPECTED ROLL vied for the early lead four wide, then faded quickly in the stretch.
