REGAL BET raced midpack, closed four-wide late turn, took command a furlong out and held sway under a hand ride. PRAYINGALLTHEWAY raced off the pace, closed late turn then rallied gamely four-wide. RUE DE JEAN, clear quickly, set a reserved pace but tired in the stretch. LOVELY QUID, in range along the second path, was roused late turn but evened out in the late stages. KENDAL MINT raced off the pace, angled gradually from the rail to four-wide on the turn then lacked a strong late response. JUST ENOUGH SPICE, in striking range, was roused late turn but showed no response and flattened out. PEAK EFFICIENCY, in contention to late turn, tired. STREAK THE WEDDING raced off the pace, was hustled late turn but never reached contention. EXECUTIVE JEWEL dropped well back early, trailed throughout and lacked a rally.
