Footnotes

PASSIONISTA broke outward and bumped SEPIA, was sent to the lead, set the pace then held under a drive. PETITE D'OR showed brief speed but was headed, chased, was roused late turn and finished all out. GENE'S BLUE MOON, off slowly, chased up close, was steadied along the rail at the turn, continued to be hustled to the stretch then finished gamely. SUPER AMAZING, outrun early, closed outside rivals late backstretch, chased four-wide on the turn but evened out in the late stages. SHIVELY, in touch early, dropped back, chased two and three-wide on the turn and did not regain contention. PEARLS GALORE dropped off the early pace, trailed under a ride on the turn and failed to menace. SEPIA, bumped at the start, chased close up, dropped back on the turn and tired in the stretch.
