The purse to be divided: 60% to the winner, 20% to second, 10% to third, 5% to fourth, 2% to fifth, 1% to sixth, 1% to seventh, 1% to eighth. Weight Three-Year-Olds 122 lbs.; Older 126 lbs.; Non-winners of a Grade I race in 2013, allowed 3 lbs.; Of a Grade II race in 2013 or a Grade I race in 2012, 5 lbs.; Of a Grade III race in 2013 or a Grade II race in 2012, 7 lbs.; Of a Sweepstakes of \$60,000 in 2013 or a Grade III race in 2012, 9 lbs. (No Canadian Bred Allowance.) (Note: Grades as recognized by the International Cataloguing Standards Committee.) Final entries to be made through the entry box at the closing time then in effect for overnight events. A supplemental nomination may be made no later than the time of final entry, by a non-refundable fee of \$4,000, which includes the entry fee. (Closed with 22 Nominations and 1 Supplement) *Plus up to \$24,300 Ontario Sired/Ontario Bred Breeder Awards.

DIMENSION (GB) dueled on the backstretch, held a short lead into the turn, set a pressured pace, shook clear at the top of the stretch then held sway under steady handling. EXCAPER forced the issue, chased into the stretch and finished under a determined drive. RIDING THE RIVER settled midpack,

angled out leaving the turn, rallied widest and from far back but gained steadily to the end. GO BLUE OR GO HOME stalked the pace, chased into the stretch and finished all out. UPGRADE raced off the pace, came two to four-wide through the turn, was hustled into the stretch and rallied gamely. BURNUM, in midpack early, saved ground then finished gamely between foes. ARTEST stalked the pace, was hustled along the rail late turn then evened out in the stretch. VALENTINO BEAUTY, in range, came two to four-wide through the turn, chased, but evened out in the late stages. NIGHT OFFICER raced off the pace, came along the rail and two-wide on the turn, chased into the stretch but never reached contention. DANGER BAY dueled early, forced the pace on the turn, chased into the stretch and tired. DAN THE TIN MAN, in touch early, came five to seven-wide through the turn, chased into the stretch then tired in the final furlong. TRIPLE CROSS settled well off the pace, angled inward on the backstretch, trailed the field and never reached contention.
