Footnotes

SOUNDTRACK was slow early along the rail, roused between horses on the turn, swung outside of the leaders in the drive and closed strong in deep stretch getting up in the final strides well off the rail. LIBRETTO was allowed to settle close up outside of rivals in the early going, rallied four wide entering the stretch, gained command in the late going and finished well, but could not hold off the charging winner. SKIPPING STONE was void of early speed, raced three wide on the turn and rallied belatedly five wide. POETICALLY settled in the middle of the pack just off the rail in the early going, waited patiently on the turn and finished with a mild bid in the drive. SERENA'S TUNE stalked the early pace inside of rivals, drew even outside of the early leader DREAMS GO BYE in upper stretch and put a head in front between calls then tired in the late going. CLUBAY was close up inside of rivals and failed to respond dropping back in the drive. DREAMS GO BYE broke sharply and set the early pace in hand, faltered in mid stretch and faded in the final furlong. PHONE DANCER was off slowly and allowed to settle inside of rivals well off the lead, never rallied and was never a threat. LOVE AND MARRY stalked the early pace off the rail, closed the gap three wide entering the stretch, but failed to sustain the bid and dropped back in the drive. FOXY CONNECTION was unhurried early off the rail and outrun.
