GRAND ADVENTURE stalked the pace, bid three-wide upper stretch, dueled then drove clear a furlong out. SMOKEY FIRE showed brief speed but was headed approaching the turn, pressed the pace, bid at the top of the stretch, dueled to the final furlong and yielded. MICHAEL'S BAD BOY, always in touch, was hustled from the top of the stretch and finished gamely in vain. WOLLEMI PINE raced off the pace, chased into the stretch, was all out but failed to threaten. THE GREAT CARUSO led into the turn, shook clear, was engaged at the top of the stretch, yielded with 3/16th to run and tired. SWINTON raced off the pace, chased three-wide into the stretch then evened out in the late stages.
