### Footnotes

SILVERLEO closed on the backstretch and stalked the pace, gained four-wide midturn, came five-wide into the stretch, launched an all out drive and got by late. WHIPPIT vied on the backstretch and turn, gained a short lead at the top of the stretch, turned back MO STAR then came out a bit, straightened away but failed to stave off the winner in the late stages. BREAKING BALL stalked the pace, steadied upper stretch and again midstretch when blocked, was lugging in and evened out late. GRAN TSAR settled off the pace, was hustled four-wide late turn, was game in the stretch but evened out late. MO STAR dueled three-wide, was headed briefly at the top of the stretch, rebid but failed to sustain the drive and tired. MR. UNCLE NED closed late backstretch then vied briefly early turn, backed away but was still in contention and chased into the stretch and tired. A STEWARDS' INQUIRY INTO THE STRETCH RUN CONCERNING BREAKING BALL AND WHIPPIT LEFT THE RESULTS AS POSTED.
