Footnotes

EXETER ROAD, off slowly, closed angling from three to five-wide through the turn, chased into the stretch, swept to the lead a furlong out, was lightly kept to business then was taken well in hand in the late stages. I WANT YOU TO KNOW forced the pace on the backstretch, stalked three to five-wide on the turn, lodged his bid at the top of the stretch, dueled, led briefly midstretch but was passed and chased to the end. BUFFALO STORM, in touch, angled from the rail to four-wide on the turn, chased into the stretch, was game but did not menace. STORM PURSUIT, rated off the pace, saved ground then finished evenly along the rail. CATCH THE SUN saved ground from off the pace, angled out through the stretch under an all out drive. DOUBLE DOUBLE led quickly, shared the lead from early turn, dueled in earnest into the stretch but tired. SEMINARIAN stalked the pace, moved up to partner with the early pacesetter on the turn, dueled into the stretch and tired. NORTHUMBERLAND raced in midpack early then settled off the pace, was hustled along but lacked a stretch response.
