QUEEN OF THE WAVES led quickly, set a reserved pace, quickened on the turn and held sway under a drive. QUINTE WEST, off slowly, settled in midpack, angled from the rail to three-wide through the turn then finished determinedly. STRIKE IT GREEN stalked the pace, closed angling from the rail to three-wide late turn then finished gamely. BENITA BLUE settled off the pace, chased hard two-wide late turn then rallied belatedly. CRY WAR EAGLE, in range, angled five-wide late turn, was steady when she ducked in a bit upper stretch then finished all out. SOUL CITY stalked the pace, angled two to four-wide through the turn then finished evenly. CHOCOLATO raced off the pace, was hustled three-wide late turn and never reached contention. SWINGINONSATURDAY closed up and forced the pace late backstretch, chased on the turn then tired upper stretch.
