VANDERLIN (GB) raced midpack along the rail, angled out upper stretch and closed through traffic, gained steadily and got up in the final yards under a furious drive. LE CINQUIEME ESSAI stalked three-wide, bid at the top of the stretch, gained the lead approaching the furlong marker then failed to hold in deep stretch. FRANK'S SELECTION stalked from the rail, was blocked upper stretch then rallied gamely when clear. OLD FORESTER raced off the pace, closed three-wide late turn then rallied willingly. FORT PRADO, well back early on the rail, angled out and closed through traffic in the stretch. SOARING FREE broke alertly, held a short lead, was engaged entering the turn, dueled, then yielded grudgingly upper stretch. AWESOME ACTION raced off the pace three-wide, swung widest at the top of the stretch but lacked the necessary rally. MY LUCKY STRIKE settled early, trailed, then passed tiring horses. DALAVIN, in range four-wide, flattened out in the stretch. ALL STAR LOVER stalked from between horses, was all out upper stretch then tired.

BLAKELOCK, in touch early between foes, lacked a rally. MINISTERS WILD CAT stalked the pace, bid into the turn, dueled, gained a slight lead at the top of the stretch then tired. I THEE WED, rated in range, raced three-deep but tired at the top of the stretch.
